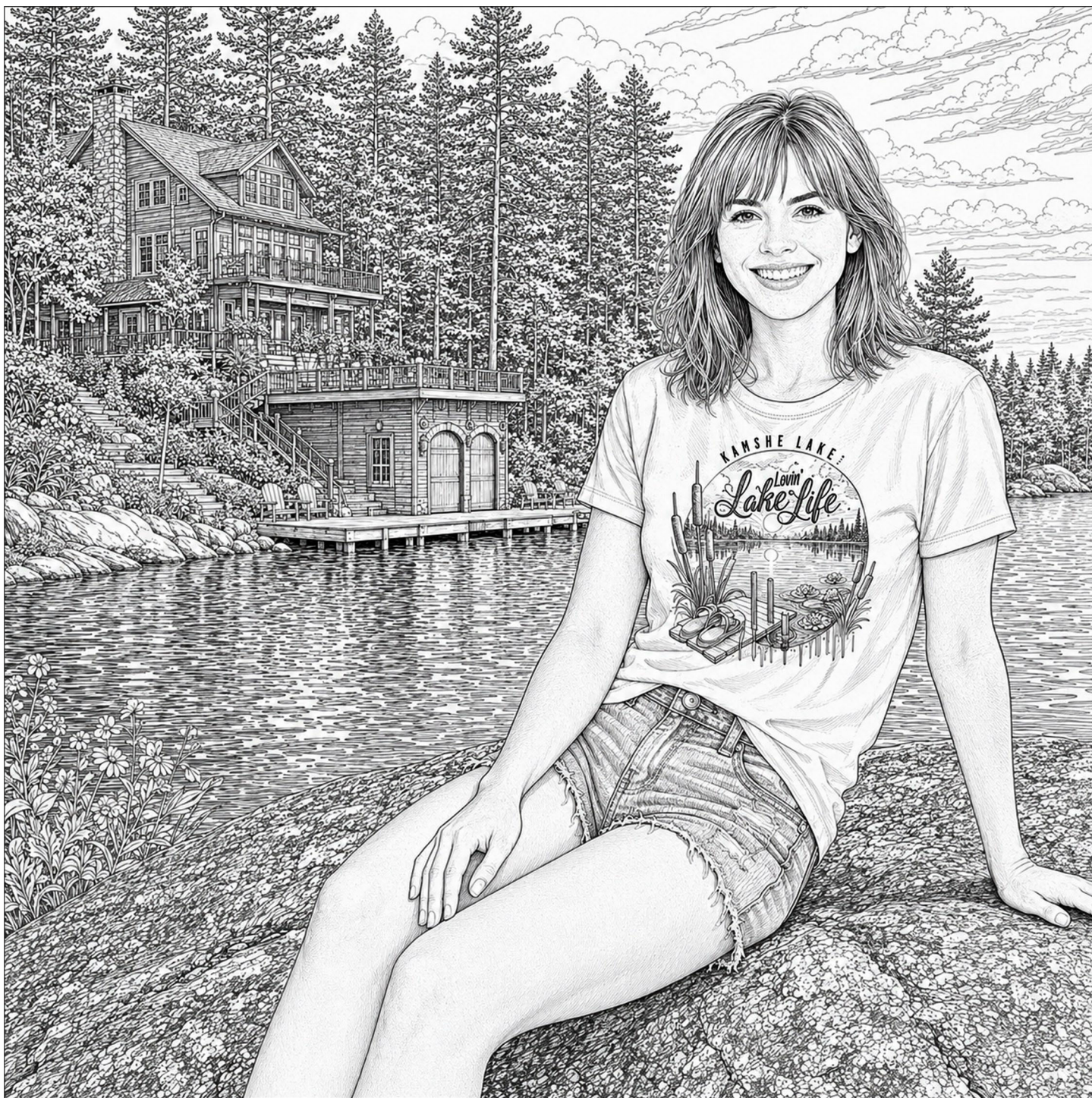




Kahshe Lake is a mid-sized, tea-colored lake in the Muskoka region, located just south of Gravenhurst and under two hours from the GTA. Known for its rugged Canadian Shield granite and high concentration of islands, it is home to roughly 600 cottages, many of which are water-access only.



The lake supports healthy populations of smallmouth and largemouth bass, walleye, northern pike, and muskellunge. With intricate bays and numerous islands (including the massive Boyd Island), it is highly popular for kayaking and canoeing.
