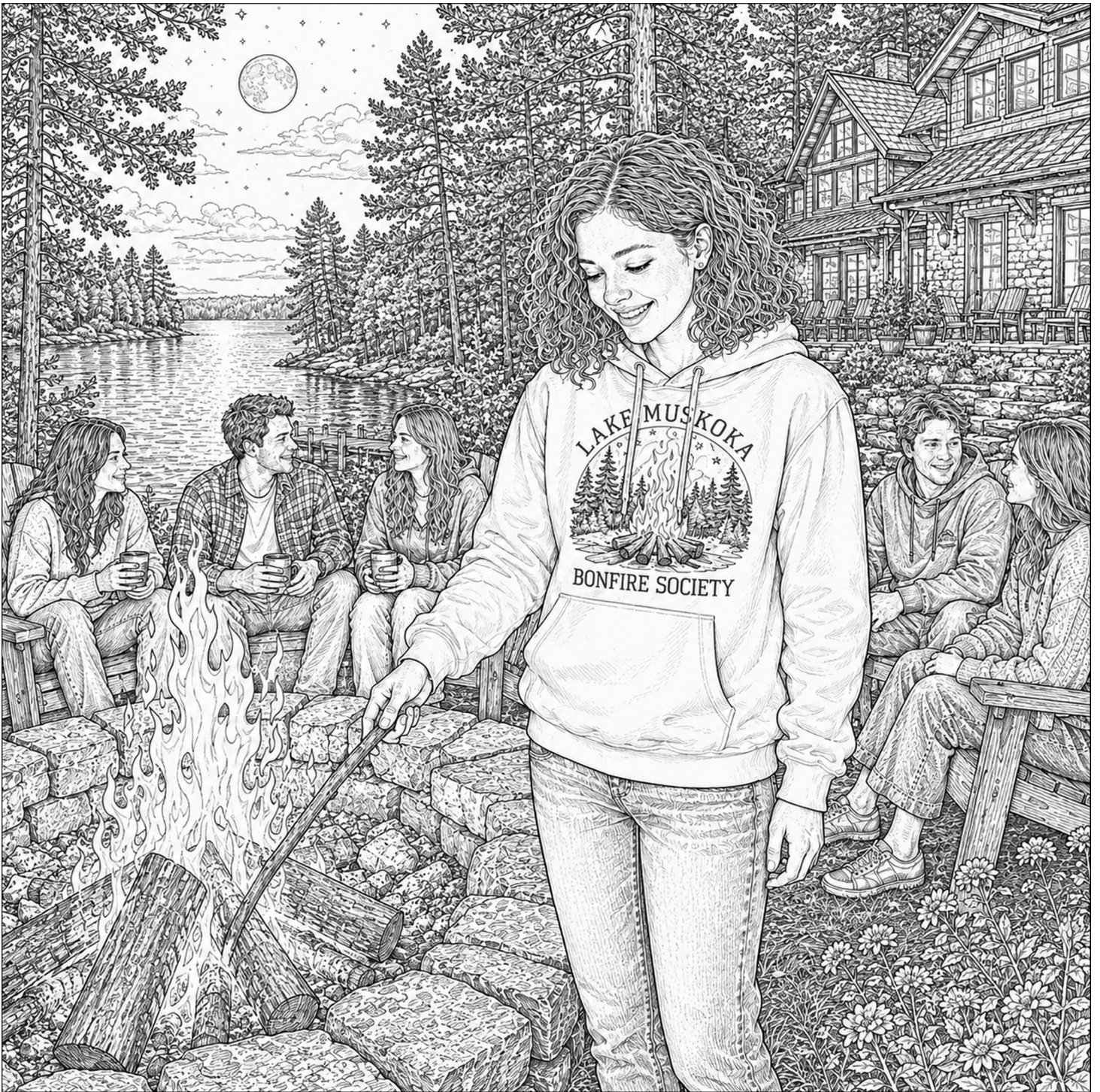




Lake Muskoka is the largest of the "Big Three" lakes in Ontario's cottage country. Spanning 121 square kilometers with over 400 islands, it features a highly indented shoreline fed by the Muskoka River and is connected to Lakes Rosseau and Joseph via the historic locks at Port Carling.



Known as the most active and socially vibrant of the big lakes, it is a hotbed for boating, water sports, and classic family cottage culture.
