



Lake of Bays is a large, deep, and picturesque four-season destination in northeastern Muskoka. Located about 2 hours north of Toronto and neighboring Algonquin Provincial Park, it is the second-largest lake in the region with nearly 563 km of rugged shoreline and a rich logging and steamship history.



The deep, crystal-clear waters (reaching depths up to 79 meters) are ideal for swimming, fishing (lake trout and bass).
