



Lake Rosseau is a premium, highly sought-after lake in Ontario's Muskoka region, located about 200 km (2 hours) north of Toronto. Spanning roughly 6,300 hectares with 151 km of shoreline, it is celebrated for its oligotrophic, crystal-clear waters (up to 6 m visibility), rugged granite shorelines, and luxurious cottage lifestyle.



Its deep, cold waters (reaching up to 89 m deep) make it an exceptional environment for Lake Trout fishing, as well as Bass and Pike.
