



Skeleton Lake is a stunning, deeply clear spring-fed lake located in the District Municipality of Muskoka, Ontario, about 17 km (11 miles) west of Huntsville. Famous for its rugged granite shores and great depths, it spans roughly 396 hectares (979 acres) and is believed to have been formed by a meteor strike.



A popular destination for catching lake trout, smallmouth bass, and northern pike. Devil's Face is a popular rocky cliff landmark, and islands like The Hog's Back and Anderson's Island are well-known spots for sightseeing and cliff jumping.
